
Knitting and Tea and Cookies - Spring 2010 Mystery KAL - 3rd Clue

<u>Materials</u>

Section Two cont'd

Americo Linen Tanguis [50% tanguis cotton, Row 29: K1, K2tog, yo, K4, ssk, K1, RT, K4, RT, K1, yo, ssk, K3, K2tog, K4, yo, ssk, K1 – 31 sts 50% linen; 218 yd/199 m per 100g]; color I158; 1 Row 30: S11, P10, s11, P3, s11, P5, s11, P to last st, s11 skein (this solid colour is a grey/blue/green tone.) If Substituting Yarn: choose a non-fluffy yarn Row 31: K2tog, yo, K5, ssk, K6, LT, K3, LT, K2tog, K5, yo, ssk – 29 sts (the better to show stitches crisply), in a colour Row 32: S11, P12, s11, P to last st, s11 flattering to you, in a worsted/10 ply/ 9wpi weight; 130 yards will be enough for all 4 clues. Row 33: K3, K2tog, yo, K2, ssk, K3, RT, K1, LT, K3, K2tog, K2, yo, ssk, K3 – 27 sts 1 set US #6/4mm straight needles (or size to Row 34: Sl1, P10, sl1, P3, sl1, P to last st, sl1 obtain gauge) Row 35: K2, K2tog, yo, K3, ssk, K1, RT, K3, LT, K1, K2tog, K3, yo, ssk, K2 - 25 sts 1 tapestry needle 1 sewing needle Row 36: S11, P8, s11, [P2, s11] twice, P to last st, s11 2-3 clear plastic buttons, 5/8" wide Row 37: K1, K2tog, yo, K4, ssk, K7, K2tog, K4, yo, ssk, K1 – 23 sts **Optional.** for fourth clue only: 3-4 clear plastic buttons, small sizes Row 38: S11, P10, s11, P to last st, s11 Gauge Row 39: K2tog, yo, K5, ssk, K5, K2tog, K5, yo, ssk – 21 sts 20 sts/24 rows = 4'' in stockinette stitchRow 40: S11, P9, s11, P to last st, s11 **Note**: with the exception of the sl2tog, K1, psso decrease, slipped stitches should be slipped Row 41: K3, K2tog, yo, K2, ssk, K3, K2tog, K2, yo, ssk, K3 – 19 sts purlwise, with the yarn held to the wrong side of Row 42: S11, P8, s11, P to last st, s11 the work (which is to say, in front.) Row 43: K2, K2tog, yo, K3, ssk, K1, K2tog, K3, yo, ssk, K2 - 17 sts Abbreviations K: knit Row 44: S11, P7, s11, P to last st, s11 **K2tog**: knit two together Row 45: K1, K2tog, yo, K4, sl2tog, K1, psso, K4, yo, ssk, K1 – 15 sts LT: left twist (drop next st on left needle to front of work, K1, pick up dropped st and K) Row 46: S11, P6, s11, P to last st, s11 **P**: purl Row 47: K2tog, yo, K4, sl2tog, K1, psso, K4, yo, ssk - 13 sts **RT**: right twist (skip next st on left needle, k 2nd st in front of skipped st, then K skipped st) Row 48: Sl1, P5, sl1, P to last st, sl1 sl2tog, K1, psso: slip two together, knit one, pass Row 49: K3, K2tog, yo, sl2tog, K1, psso, yo, ssk, K3 - 11 sts slipped sts over (slip two sts knitwise as though they were one, K1, pass slipped sts over knit st) Row 50: S11, P4, s11, P to last st, s11 **ssk**: slip slip knit Row 51: K2, K2tog, yo, sl2tog, K1, psso, yo, ssk, K2 – 9 sts st: stitch Row 52: S11, P3, s11, P to last st, s11 yo: yarn over Row 53: K1, K2tog, yo, sl2tog, K1, psso, yo, ssk, K1 – 7 sts

Row 54: S11, P2, s11, P to last st, s11 Row 55: K2tog, yo, sl2tog, K1, psso, yo, ssk – 5 sts Row 56: S11, [P1, s11] twice Row 57: K1, sl2tog, K1, psso, K1 – 3 sts Row 58: S11, P1, s11 Row 59: Sl2tog, K1, psso – 1 st



Finishing

Cut tail and pull through remaining st; run in ends and wet block.

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
