## Best Friends Beanie

A simple cable pattern summarizes the way friends interact over a problem - one talking, one supporting, and both sharing a hug as snug as the negative ease in this quick knit!

## Materials

Viola M/C/N Worsted (80\% merino wool, 10\% nylon, $10 \%$ cashmere; $183 \mathrm{~m} / 115 \mathrm{~g}$ ), 1 skein - buy online at www.etsy.com/ca/shop/violaviola 4.0 mm double pointed needles (you may use a 16 " circular needle for the body of the hat) or size to obtain gauge
Stitch marker for start of round, if using a circular needle
Cable needle
Tapestry needle to run in ends

## Sizing

Close fitting toque offered in three sizes from small child to youth to adult; shown in size M stretched over a $22 "$ head.
Size S (M, L) - 16" around, 6-3/4" long (18-1/2" around, 7" long; 21" around, 7-1/2" long)

## Gauge

20 sts 31 rows $=4$ " in stocking stitch

## Abbreviations

C4L: Cable 4 left - slip next 2 sts onto cable needle to hold at front of work, K2, K2 sts from cable needle
C4R: Cable 4 right - slip next 2 sts onto cable needle to hold at back of work, K2, K2 sts from cable needle
K: knit
K2tbl: knit the next two stitches through their back loop (twisting the knit stitch)
K2tog: knit two together (decrease 1)
Pfb: purl into front and back of stitch (increase 1) st (s): stitch(es)

## Directions

Cast on $72(81,90)$ sts, divide onto 4 needles and join to work in the round or, if using a circular needle, slip on a stitch marker and join to work in the round.

## Ribbing

Rounds 1-7: *K2tbl, P1; repeat from * to end of round.
Round 8: *[K2tbl, Pfb] twice, K2tbl, P1; repeat from * to end of round - $90(99,108)$ sts.

## Body

Rounds 1 and all subsequent odd rounds: P2, K4, P2, K4, P2, K to end of round.
Round 2: P2, K4, P2, C4R, P2, K to end of round.
Rounds 4, 8, 12: P2, C4L, P2, K4, P2, K to end of round.
Rounds 6 \& 10: as Round 1.


Repeat Rounds 1-12 twice, then rounds 1-2 (1-4, 1-8) once.

## Crown - Size S

Round 1: P2, K4, P2, K2tog, K2, P2, K4, K2tog, *K8, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 81sts Round 2: P2, C4L, P2, K3, P2, K to end.
Round 3: P2, K4, P1, K2tog, K2, P2, K3, K2tog, *K7, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 72 sts
Round 4: P2, K4, P1, K3, P2, K to end
Round 5: P2, K4, K2tog, K2, P2, K2, K2tog, *K6, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 63 sts
Round 6: P2, C4L, K3, P2, K to end
Round 7: P2, K3, K2tog, K2, P2, K1, K2tog; *K5, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 54 sts
Round 8: P2, K6, P2, K to end
Round 9: P2, K2, K2tog, K2, P2, K2tog; *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 45 sts
Round 10: P2, K1, C4R, P2, K to end
Round 11: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 36 sts


Round 12: Knit
Round 13: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 27 sts
Round 14 and all further even rounds: Knit
Round 15: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 18 sts
Round 17: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 9 sts
Proceed to Finishing

## Crown - Size M

Round 1: P2, K4, P2, K1, K2tog, K1, P2, K6, K2tog, *K9, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 90 sts
Round 2: P2, K4, P2, K3, P2, K to end
Round 3: P2, K4, P2, K2tog, K1, P2, K5, K2tog, *K8, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 81 sts
Round 4: P2, C4L, P2, K2, P2, K to end
Round 5: P2, K4, P1, K2tog, K1, P2, K4, K2tog, *K7, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 72 sts Round 6: P2, K4, P1, K2, P2, K to end
Round 7: P2, K4, K2tog, K1, P2, K3, K2tog, *K6, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 63 sts
Round 8: P2, C4L, K2, P2, K to end
Round 9: P2, K3, K2tog, K1, P2, K2, K2tog, *K5, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 54 sts
Round 10: P2, K1, C4R, P2, K to end
Round 11: P2, K2, K2tog, K1, P2, K1, K2tog, *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 45 sts
Round 12: P2, C4R, P2, K to end
Round 13: P2, K1, K2tog, K1, P2, K2tog, *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 36 sts
Round 14: P2, K3, P2, K to end
Round 15: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 27 sts
Rounds 16 and all further even rounds: Knit
Round 17: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 18 sts
Round 19: *K2tog; repeat from * to end - 9 sts
Proceed to Finishing


## Crown - Size L

Round 1: P2, K4, P2, K2, K2tog, P1, K9, K2tog, *K10, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 99 sts
Round 2: P2, K4, P2, K3, P1, K to end
Round 3: P2, K4, P2, K1, K2tog, P1, K8, K2tog, *K9, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 90 sts
Round 4: P2, C4L, P2, K2, P1, K to end
Round 5: P2, K4, P2, K2tog, P1, K7, K2tog, *K8, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 81 sts
Round 6: P2, K3, C4R, P1, K to end (note: knit all 4 sts of the C4R here, including the P sts)
Round 7: P2, K5, K2tog, P1, K6, K2tog, *K7, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 72 sts
Round 8: P2, C4R, K2, P1, K to end
Round 9: P2, K4, K2tog, P1, K5, K2tog, *K6, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 63 sts
Round 10: P2, K5, P1, K to end
Round 11: *K5, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 54 sts
Round 12 and all further even rounds: Knit
Round 13: *K4, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 45 sts
Round 15: *K3, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 36 sts
Round 17: *K2, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 27 sts
Round 19: *K1, K2tog; repeat from * to end - 18 sts
Round 21: * K2tog; repeat from * to end -9 sts

## Finishing

Cut 8 " tail and run through 9 remaining live sts; tack down inside hat. Run in cast-on tail and wet block.
