# Good Fences Scarf

Named for its repeating suggestion of chain link fences and hedges, the odd number of pattern rows for this highly textured scarf make it reversible. Not only is this the perfect, portable, unisex and gift-able use for one-off skeins so irresistible in the store, varying stitch counts between Rows 1-3 help break up pooling in variegated yarns.

#### Materials

Colinette ART (19% wool, 21% bamboo) – 173 m, 189 yds/100g, 1 skein Autumn Leaves.

1 pair straight 4.5mm needles or size to obtain gauge.

## **Gauge**

16 sts, 18 rows = 4", in pattern stitch, after blocking.

# **Finished Size**

39" long x 8" wide

### **Abbreviations**

K: knit

**K2tog**: knit two together

P: purl

st(s): stitch(es)
yo: yarn over



#### **Directions**

Cast on 34 sts.

Setup: K1, P to last st, K.

Row 1: K1, \*yo, K1; rep from \* to last st, K1 - 66 sts.

Row 2: K1, P to last st, K1.

Row 3: K1, \*K2tog, repeat from \* to last st, K1 - 34 sts.

Rows 4 & 5: K1, \*yo, K2tog; repeat from \* to last st, K1.

Row 6: K1, P to last st, K1.

Row 7: K to end of row.

Repeat rows 1-7 24 times more.

Work rows 1-3 once more.

Work rows 6 & 7.

Cast off loosely.

# **Finishing**

Run in ends and wet block.

While wet, pin scarf out on a blocking mat or bed to 39" long and 8" wide.

Let air dry, remove pins, and enjoy!
