## Graduated Ribs Hat

Sometimes it's good to get out of the way of a semisolid or variegated yarn and let a simple stitch show it off. The graduated rib pattern of this unisex hat allows varying elements of the yarn's colour to come to the forefront, and ensures a snug fit on a cold day. If you want a different set of ridges, just turn it inside out!

## Materials

Araucania Toconao (100\% Merino, 139 yds/100g), 1 skein \#401, green blue 4.5 mm double pointed needles (dpns) or size to obtain gauge
stitch marker
darning needle

## Gauge

17 sts, 26 rows $=4$ " in st st after blocking.

## Finished Dimensions

The ribbed structure gives this hat significant stretch; size M fits a $21.5^{\prime \prime}$ head comfortably. S (M; L) 16" around, 7" long (18" around, 7.25" long; 20" around, 7.5" long)

## Abbreviations

## K: knit.

K2tog: Knit two together.
P: purl.
P2tog: purl two together.
st(s): stitch(es).


## Directions

Using 4.5 mm needles, cast on $81(90,99)$ sts, divide onto dpns, place marker, and join to work in the round.

## Body

Round 1: *K2, P2, K3, P3, K4, P4, K3, P3, K2, P1; repeat from * to last $0(9,18)$ sts, [P1, K2, P3, K2, P1] 0, (1, 2) times. Repeat Round 1 until hat measures 4.5 " from cast on.

## Crown

Round 1: *[K7 (8, 9), K2 tog] twice, P7 (8, 9), P2tog; repeat from * to end of round - $72(81,90)$ sts.
Round 2 and all even rows: K all knit sts, P all purl sts.
Round 3: *[K6 (7, 8), K2 tog] twice, P6 (7, 8), P2tog; repeat from * to end of round - $63(72,81)$ sts.

right side

reverse side

Round 5: *[K5 (6, 7), K2 tog] twice, P5 (6, 7), P2tog; repeat from * to end of round - $54(63,72)$ sts.
Round 7: *[K4 (5, 6), K2 tog] twice, P4 $(5,6)$, P2tog; repeat from * to end of round $-45(54,63)$ sts.
Round 9: *[K3 $(4,5), \mathrm{K} 2 \mathrm{tog}]$ twice, P3 $(4,5)$, P2tog; repeat from * to end of round $-36(45,54)$ sts.
Round 11: *[K2 (3, 4), K2 tog] twice, P2 (3, 4), P2tog; repeat from * to end of round - $27(36,45)$ sts.
Round 13: *[K1 (2, 3), K2 tog] twice, P1 $(2,3)$, P2tog; repeat from * to end of round $-18(27,36)$ sts.
Round 15: *[K0 $(1,2), \mathrm{K} 2$ tog twice, P0 $(1,2)$, P2tog; repeat from * to end of round - $9(18,27)$ sts - size S ends here; proceed to Finishing.
Round 17: *[-(0, 1), K2 tog] twice, $\mathrm{P}-(0,1)$,
P2 tog; repeat from * to end of round - - $(9,18)$ sts - size M ends here; proceed to Finishing.

Round 19: *[- (-, 0), K2 tog] twice, $\mathrm{P}-(-, 0)$, P2 tog; repeat from *to end of round - $-(-, 9)$ sts - size L ends here; proceed to Finishing.

## Finishing

Cut an 8-10" tail and thread darning needle with it, run through remaining 9 live sts, run in ends, and block hat.
