## **Togetherness Cowl**

A nubbly texture gives this soft, unisex, reversible cowl interest while providing a well-constructed fabric that won't fold over in use. It makes a very special gift for someone who's loved, or who needs a lift (or both!). Two rounds make a straightforward K1, P1 ribbing, but the other two prevent it from folding in on itself, protecting purls between knits and knits between purls – just as we stand up for the people in our lives.

## **Materials**

Semisolid shade of Twisted Fiber Art Duchess (100% superwash merino wool, 240 yds/100g) 1 skein, shown in Suede, a coordinate for Dapper self-striping yarn US 6/4.0 mm 16" circular needle stitch marker darning needle <u>Gauge</u> 20 sts, 28 rows = 4" in stocking stitch <u>Finished Dimensions</u> 19" circumference, 6" long <u>Abbreviations</u> K: knit. P: purl. st(s): stitch(es).



## **Directions**

Using 4.0 mm needles, cast on 120 sts. Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Rounds 1, 2: \*K1, P1; repeat from \* to end of round.

Rounds 3, 4: \*K2, P1, K2, P2, K1, P2; repeat from \* to end of round.

Repeat Rounds 1-4 ten times more; repeat Round 1 once.

Cast off, following stitch instructions for Round 2.

## Finishing

Cut an 8-10" tail, run in ends, and block.



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
