Triple Lane Travel Cowl

No need for a marker with this quick reversible cowl, which features a distinctive stitch at the start and end of each round; circular needles make it great for tight knitting spaces. Repeat rows of simple stitches let you gaze from a window en route or enjoy the sights from a cozy café on arrival without missing a beat. Wear it (it's just long enough to pull up over your chin if it's cold), tuck something soft inside to turn it into a travel pillow on your way home, or gift it to one of your travel companions as a very special souvenir!

Materials

Rowan Pure Wool DK (100% wool, 136 yards, 50g), 2 (2, 2) balls 4.0mm 16" circular or double point needles, or size to obtain gauge stitch marker (optional)

darning needle

Gauge

21 sts, 32 rows = 4" in stocking st, after blocking

Finished Dimensions

S (M, L): 17 (18, 19)" circumference, 7.5" long. Shown in size Small.

Abbreviations

K: knit. K2tbl: knit next two sts through back loop. **P**: purl.



Directions

Using 4.0 mm circular needles, cast on 88, 96 (104) sts, place marker if desired and – being careful not to twist – join to work in the round. The hanging cast-on tail indicates the last P2 of the round until the marker pattern begins.

Border One

Round 1: *K2tbl, P2; repeat from * to end.

Repeat Round 1 11 times more (12 rounds of ribbing.)

Body

Rounds 1-3: K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

Rounds 4-6: Knit.

Rounds 7-12: P2, K to last 2 sts, K2tbl.

Rounds 13-15: K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

Rounds 16-18: Knit.

Rounds 19-23: K2tbl, K to last 2 sts, P2.

Repeat Round 1-15 once more.

Border Two

Round 1: *K2tbl, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

Repeat Round 1 10 times more (11 rounds of ribbing.)

Cast off loosely in pattern as set.

Finishing

Cut an 8-10" tail. run in ends and block.
