UpCountry Cowl

Pull up this snug, unisex cowl to hug your chin on icy days. On cold ones, let the textured stitch fold the extra length out of your way. Quick and simple, it makes a great gift.

Twisted Fiber Art Duchess Self-Striping yarn (100% superwash merino wool, 240 yards, 100g), 1 skein (www.twistedfiberart.com) 4.0mm 16" circular or double point needles,	Using 4.0 mm circular needles, cast on 96 (104) sts, place marker, and – being careful not to twist – join to work in the round.

or size to obtain gauge stitch marker	Rounds 1-3: Knit.
darning needle	Rounds 4-12: *K2tbl, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
Gauge	Body
20 sts, 28 rows = 4" in stocking st, after blocking	Rounds 1-2: Knit.
Finished Dimensions	Rounds 3-6: *K4, P4; repeat from * to end of round.
S (M): 18 (19.5)" circumference, 8.75" long.	Rounds 7-8: Purl.
Shown in size Small. Abbreviations	Rounds 9-12: *P4, K4; repeat from * to end of round.
K : knit.	Repeat Rounds 1-12 three times more. Repeat Rounds 1-2 once.
K2tbl : knit next two sts through back loop. P : purl.	Border Two
· . puit.	Rounds 1-8: * K2tbl, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
