

Candy Wrapper Scarflet by Mary Keenan

This little wrap scarf is surprisingly versatile - the hidden button slips through holes left by the picot bindoff at any point you like for a snug or loose collar, and you can rotate it to set the tip front and center or up on the shoulder. It's warm and works like a necklace to finish an outfit beautifully: eye candy for your neck!

Materials

92m/100 yds Knitterly Things “Vesper Merino Mohair” (55% mohair, 45% merino wool, 129m/142 yds, 100g/3½ oz per skein) – 11 wraps per inch

1 set 5mm/US 8 straight or circular needles
1 stitch marker; 1 darning needle; blocking pins
1 flat-style ¾”/19mm button

Gauge

12sts & 20 rows = 4” in st st after blocking

Abbreviations

K: knit

K2tog: knit next 2 sts together (decrease 1 st)

Kfb: knit into front and back of next st before slipping it off left needle (increase 1 st)

M1: insert left needle from front to back, under horizontal bar before next st, and knit into the back of it (increase 1 st)

P: purl

PM/SM: place marker/slip marker

sl1wyib: slip 1 st with yarn in back

ssk: slip next two sts knitwise onto right needle, then insert left needle in front of both and knit them together (decrease 1 st)

Finished Dimensions

11” high x 13.5” wide (inside edges of castoff)



Directions

Cast on 75 sts.

Setup Row: [P1, K1] 11 times, P3, [K1, P1]10 times, P2, [K1, P1]11 times, P2, [K1, P1] twice

Row 1: Kfb, K1, P1, K2tog, PM, *sl1wyib, ssk, K21, M1, sl1wyib, K21, sl1wyib, M1, K to last 2 sts, K2tog*

Row 2: and all even rows S11, P to last 2 sts, K1, bring yarn to front, sl1

Row 3: Kfb twice, P1, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1 – 76 sts

Row 5: Kfb, K1, P1, K1, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1

Row 7: Kfb twice, P1, K1, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1 – 77 sts

Row 9: Kfb, K1, P1, K2, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1

Row 11: Kfb twice, P1, K2, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1 – 78 sts

Row 13: Kfb, K1, P1, K3, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1

Row 15: Kfb twice, P1, K3, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1 – 79 sts

Row 17: Kfb, K1, P1, K4, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1

Row 19: Kfb twice, P1, K4, K2tog, SM, work from * to * on Row 1 – 80 sts

Work Picot Bind Off as follows:

Bind off 2 sts, *sl st back to left needle, cast on 3 sts, bind off 5 sts; repeat from * until 4 sts rem. Bind off.

Finishing

Run in tails and wet block, drawing out picot edges to pin them. When dry, sew the button to the underside of the rounded corner near the cast-on edge.
